The complexities of our young people means that different teaching methods are required for each individual. These are tailored to the unique needs, sensory profiles and learning abilities of each child and young person, taking into account their individual needs and differences.

Personalised therapy options

At Aspris Children's Services, our students benefit from access to a range of different therapies. This may include speech and language, art, music, drama and occupational therapy, to facilitate the development of communication and social interaction skills.

Specific dietary management, low arousal environments and sensory rooms provide calming and nurturing surroundings, enabling our young people who have sensory difficulties to manage their stress and anxiety levels.
