



# Lawn House

Lawn House is a residential care service for up to 6 young people aged 16 to 25 years with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties (SEBD). The home also supports associated moderate learning difficulties such as attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), along with low risk mental health needs.

The home is rated 'Good' by the Care Quality Commission (CQC) and is located in a quiet residential suburb in Hampshire. The service is within walking distance of a wide range of amenities, including shops, cafés and restaurants.

## Supporting the needs of the young people

A highly experienced staff team support the young people at Lawn House to learn, develop and build their life skills. The ultimate aim is for the young people to live independently, or with minimal support in the community.

The staff employ a nurturing approach and take full account of the voice of the young person. The team are experienced and skilled in assessing and developing care plans which are regularly reviewed, monitored and adjusted according to individual needs and preferences.

The young people at the home are empowered to set and achieve realistic goals and aspirations. This can involve supporting individuals to access services such as education and therapy.

- A spacious, homely and nurturing environment

## The facilities available

The home is a large detached property, which is furnished to a high standard. The young people are encouraged to personalise their bedrooms, which all have en-suite facilities.

There is a wide range of spacious communal areas for the young people to enjoy, including a large living room, dining room and smaller lounge for quieter activities. The kitchen is often the busiest area of the house with plenty of space for the preparation of meals. There is also a fully enclosed garden for barbecues and dining outdoors.
