Located in the heart of the New Forest, Coxlease School has three educational sites. The main school supports pupils from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 4. Learners can then transition to one of the bespoke post-16 sites.

- A hall for 1:1 Music lessons
- Science laboratories

There is a strong sports department and a wide range of on-site sporting facilities including:

- Extensive grounds for multi-sport use
