We also put art, culture and creativity at the heart of our curriculum and are currently in the process of securing a Bronze Arts Award.



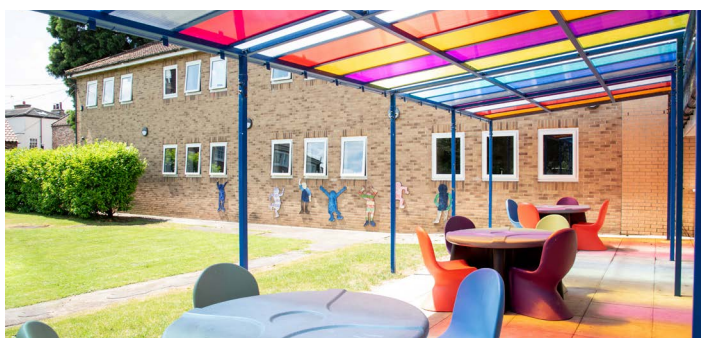
