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Located in a beautiful, quiet and rural setting in Somerset, Newbury Manor School is a specialist school for young people aged between 6 and 19 years with an autistic spectrum disorder (ASD).

Our tailored approach means that we are able to support young people with a wide range of needs, from those who are broadly average in their ability to others who have more severe learning difficulties.

We accept that young people who are referred to us may have previously experienced a 'cycle of failure' and our aim is to have a transformational impact on their lives, through experiencing our 'culture of success.' We support all young people to achieve successful adult outcomes so that they can lead fulfilling and rewarding lives.

Residential provision

Newbury Manor School has a six bedded residential home, situated in Shepton Mallet (approximately 6 miles away), for individuals who require a 38 week residential provision.

The residential home is situated within a small town, close to local facilities, and offers large communal areas including a snug, dining room, living room and conservatory. Single occupancy bedrooms all have their own en-suite bathrooms.
