Located in North Ayrshire, Radio City School supports young people aged 8 to 18 years with social, emotional and mental health (SEMH) needs and neurodivergent conditions, including an autistic spectrum disorder (ASD) and learning disabilities. Our young people have often had negative experiences in school with substantial gaps in their education.

Rated 'Good' by Education Scotland, we put our pupils at the heart of everything we do. We provide them with person-centred support to help them achieve the best possible outcomes and future success.

Our services

- A warm, welcoming and relaxed environment for pupils, with high staff to pupil ratios
- A robust and effective safeguarding culture where pupil safety and welfare are prioritised
- An individualised curriculum, with learning and support completely tailored to the individual
- A focus on developing meaningful, trusting working relationships between pupils and staff
- A highly skilled, committed and caring multidisciplinary team providing a cohesive, consistent approach to learning
- Opportunities to experience learning in a range of contexts, including outdoors and off-site
- Access to external community support, including CAMHS, therapists and counsellors
- A wide range of planned activities, volunteering and work experience opportunities (on-site and in the community)
